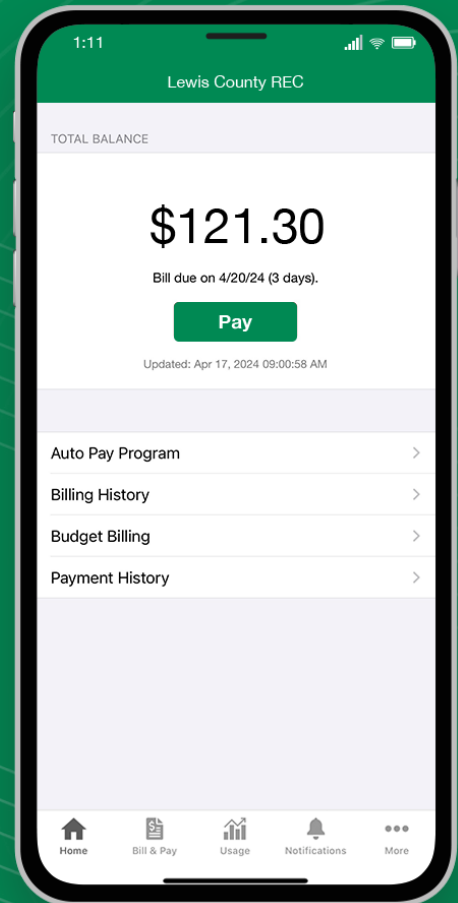
WEATHER PROVERBS
